<p>Providing arts and crafts activities and entertainment to groups of children and young people at outdoor events</p>	<p>Spreading coronavirus</p>	<p>High</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• all children clean hands before and after each activity using alcohol hand rub or sanitiser ensuring that all parts of the hands are covered - provide multiple hand sanitiser dispensers</li> <li>• children to stand whilst enjoying arts and crafts to avoid using chairs and contaminating surfaces</li> <li>• provide all staff with face coverings to be worn if necessary</li> <li>• staff clean hands very regularly and wear gloves if necessary</li> <li>• ensure good respiratory hygiene by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach - provide tissues and multiple bins</li> <li>• clean frequently touched surfaces, equipment and tools between each craft activity using standard products, such as detergents and bleach</li> <li>• minimise contact and mixing by providing fewer work areas per table and space children well apart from one another</li> <li>• staff to maintain social distancing measures from one another and others by having only one staff member per table</li> <li>• use floor markings to ensure that families queuing to enjoy the arts and crafts activities maintain social distancing measures</li> <li>• display universal, child-friendly signs to reiterate the message of how to stay safe and to stay alert at all times</li> </ul>	<p>All staff from My Arty Party will be well briefed beforehand and ensure that all safety measures are being followed by everyone at the arts and crafts area at all times.</p> <p>Any staff member with coronavirus symptoms or, who has been in contact with someone who has had symptoms within the last 14 days prior to the event, will not be permitted to attend.</p>
